



Connecting to VPN (Windows 10)

If you haven't installed the VPN client previously, you must first download and install the client. Open up a web browser and enter <http://vpn.hj.se>. Log in with your JU user name and password.


Manual Installation




Double click on the installation file and follow the on-screen instructions.

Connecting to JU

Start the client from the **Start - Cisco - Cisco AnyConnect Secure Mobility Client**, enter the address **vpn.hj.se** and your JU user name and password.



Enter **vpn.hj.se** and click “connect”



Enter your JU user name and password.

When connected, this icon is shown.

Once started, you can disconnect and reconnect by right clicking on the icon shown below.
