



# Guide to add and switch input and display language preferences in Windows 10

## Add an input language/keyboard layout

Adding an input language enables you to set a language-preference order for websites and apps, as well as change your keyboard language.

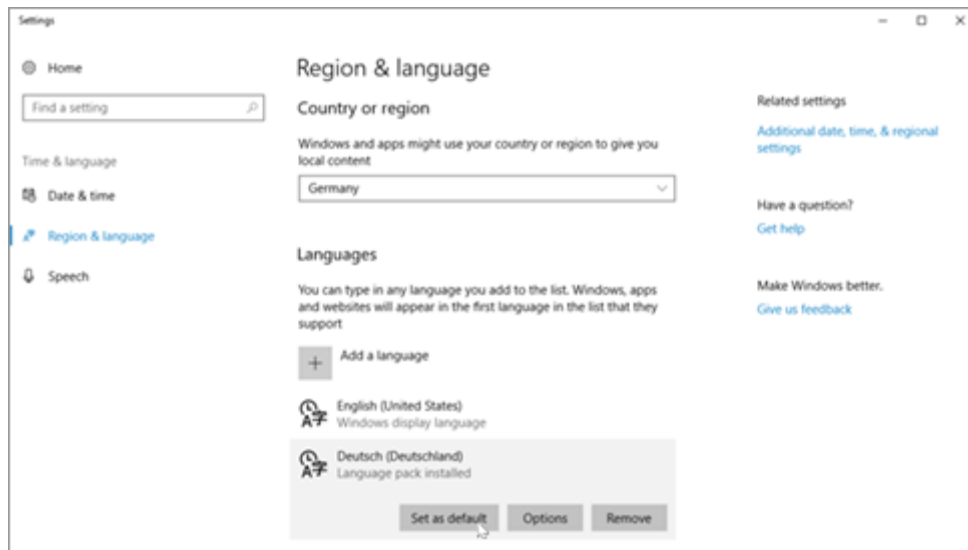
1. Select the **Start** button, then **Settings > Time & language > Region & language**
2. Select **Add a language**
3. Select the language you want to use from the list. Your download will begin immediately
4. **Note:** To switch the input language you're using in Windows 10, select the language abbreviation at the far right of your taskbar and then select the language or input method you want to use. You can also press and hold the **Windows logo** key and then repeatedly press the **Spacebar** to cycle through all your languages

## Set your display language

Changing your display language allows you to change the language your entire Windows 10 operating system will use. After installing the language pack, set that language as default to change the Windows 10 display language.

1. Go to **Start > Settings > Time & language > Region & language**
2. Choose one of your languages and then select **Options**
3. Select **Download** from the Download language pack option.
4. Once the language pack is installed, select **Back**
5. Choose one of your languages that reads **Language pack installed** and then select **Set as default** to make that language the Windows 10 display language
