Welcome to *International Communication* and to the School of Education and Communication at Jönköping University. We are happy to have you as our master's student!

*International Communication* gives you the opportunity to study media and communication in global and intercultural settings. In this international program you will study in English with people from around the world.

As most programs in Swedish universities, *International Communication* combines individual studies with scheduled lectures and seminars. This means that the student is expected to study 40 hours per week, and that unscheduled time is reserved for individual studies, for example the reading of course literature or the writing of assignments. This type of structure gives the student a relatively high amount of freedom at the same time as it requires a great deal of responsibility.

*International Communication* requires English proficiency. The student is expected to master English both in spoken and written forms in order to be able to fulfil the different moments in the program's courses.
