



Jönköping International Business School (JIBS) features a special focus on entrepreneurship, ownership and renewal within a genuinely international environment.

GRADUATE COURSE

Developing Dynamic Family Enterprises

5 ECTS credits

The course deals with different aspects of family enterprises, including the role of the family members and owners, family and non-family managers, advisors, board members and employees in developing and renewing family enterprises. We explore key issues related to governance, culture, strategic development, succession, professionalization, and portfolio entrepreneurship in family businesses.

Two very important themes that run through the course are entrepreneurship and succession. This means that we pay particular attention to the challenges family businesses face in terms of transitions processes in succession, as well as how family can establish and maintain an entrepreneurial approach to ownership and leadership across generations.

This course is a perfect choice if you are or will be involved in your family's business, would like to work in a family business and/or if you plan to become an advisor or consultant to family businesses.

UNDERGRADUATE COURSES

International Entrepreneurship and Venturing

10 ECTS credits

The formal goals of the course are to provide the students with insight into contemporary theoretical and practical developments in the area of entrepreneurship. The students should gain knowledge and experience of some of the principles and models of business venturing, including business planning, and foster a development oriented towards business activities. This course works together with the Jönköping Science Park business incubator.

International 10 ECTS Logistics and credits Supply Chain Management

The course aims to provide students with knowledge about the complex and dynamic nature of international logistics and supply chain management. It seeks to prepare its students with the skills needed in an international business environment with expected demands on not just efficiency and effectiveness, but also on the relationship skills required to manage international business in today's increasingly global business network. The course focuses on the role of management and how international logistics and supply chain management can function as a source of competitive advantage. In addition, the course will provide students with knowledge about the use and impact of e-commerce in logistics and supply chain management.

SWEDEN AND JÖNKÖPING

Jönköping is a fast-growing city with a population of 130,000 and is the centre of a region with some 340,000 inhabitants. It is located in a county characterized by its innovative and entrepreneurial spirit.

The city is easily accessible and there are excellent links between Jönköping and the major cities in Sweden as well as a good connection to the continent.

In Jönköping you will find most things around the corner. Just a short walk from campus you will find the long sandy beaches of Lake Vättern. There is a wide range of leisure and sports facilities and the great outdoors is within easy reach, offering forests, mountains and lakes. Jönköping also has a wide variety of cultural venues: theatres, museums, cinemas and concert halls.
