ENGLISH IS SPOKEN BY ALL

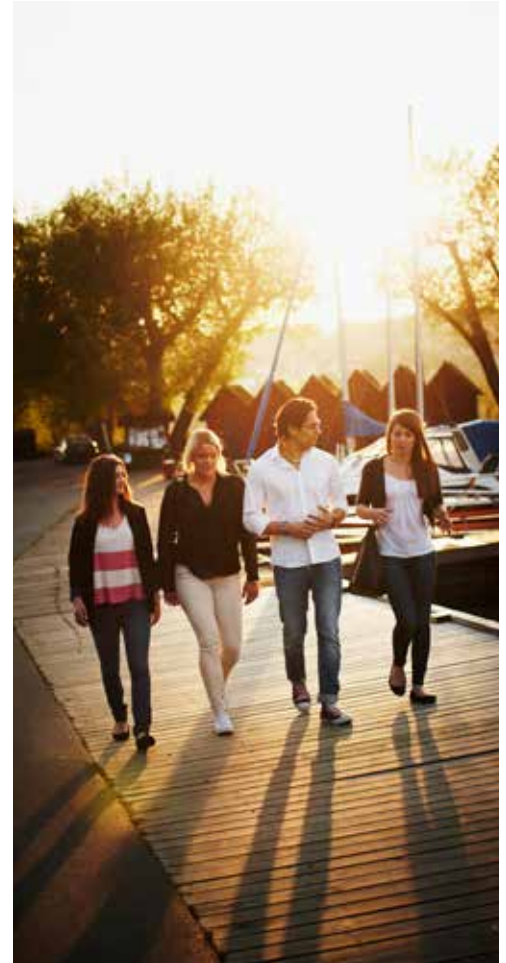
Almost all Swedes speak English well and many Swedish companies use English as their official business language.

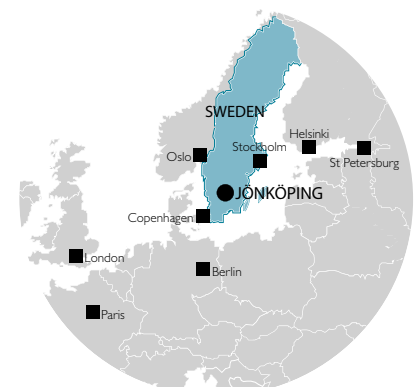
