"JU is to be characterised by an open attitude and respect for the differences between and equal value of people.

Students at JU are not to be discriminated against or harassed owing to sex, transgender identity or expression, ethnic, religion or other belief, disability, sexual orientation or age.

Nor are they to be subjected to sexual harassment."

What can YOU do?

- **Confront directly!** Leave no room for misunderstanding.
- **Write down** what has happened, so you can easily process and document the incident.
- **Tell someone** you trust what has happened.
- **Contact** your teachers, study advisor, equal treatment coordinator, student health care or chaplaincy for advice and support.
- **Report** the incident if you believe that it should be investigated formally.

**Remember,
it's not your fault!**

Diskrimination Act (2008:567)

The purpose of the Discrimination Act is to combat discrimination and promote equal rights regardless of ethnicity, religion, gender, gender identity or expression, disability, sexual orientation or age.

A higher education institution is obliged to investigate whether a student is exposed and, where appropriate, to take measures to prevent further harassment/discrimination.
