SCIENCE PARK

Science Park Jönköping provides support for the start-up, development and growth of business ventures. It is a meeting place for entrepreneurs, students and researchers and each year approximately 250-300 enterprises are started with the support of Science Park, whereof 60 are started by students.

EDUCATION

Students and staff from all over the world, combined with an international perspective throughout all education, offer students at Jönköping University an intercultural experience and prepare them for working in an international context in Sweden and abroad.

Students at Jönköping University get an education with high academic standards and profound real-world relevance. Contacts with business and society are included in the programmes, and the

majority of students find relevant jobs after graduation.

Jönköping University offers approximately 80 programmes and specialisations on Bachelor's and Master's level, as well as research education. The University also offers Pathway programmes designed for international students.




STUDENTS FROM ALL OVER THE WORLD



RESEARCH EDUCATION

Jönköping University is entitled to issue doctoral degrees in the disciplinary research domain of humanities and social sciences.
