For whom?

For those who are 12 years and older and are in habilitation or those who are legal guardians of a child who is given habilitation support.

What?

This is a research study about children's and legal guardians' participation in the support that the habilitation provides. The study is a cooperation between several universities, colleges and regions in the country.

Why?

There is a lack of knowledge whether children and legal guardians are involved in habilitation efforts, from taking stock of the child's strengths and difficulties all the way to evaluating the efforts provided.

We, together with you, want to develop knowledge about how habilitation, in the best way possible, can support children and families in their daily life.



How?

We researchers will be having focus group discussions with children, legal guardians and habilitation personnel in various groups. The groups will be meeting on one occasion.

When?

The focus group will meet at the habilitation centre for about two hours including a coffee break. This will take place during autumn 2020. Youths will need to show authorisation from their legal guardians. More information will be provided once you register to participate.
