## Dissent and Harmonies: On Literature Education, Democracy and Agonism

At the seminar, Dr Emma Nilsson-Tysklind presents her thesis which centres on the relationship between literature education and democracy, and explores this relationship both theoretically and empirically in two upper secondary classrooms. Central to the thesis is Chantal Mouffe's agonistic political theory, as well as Masschelein and Simons' educational theory on school as 'free time'. From different angles, the literature classroom is explored as a political space in itself, rather than as a place that fosters for future democratic participation.
