The arrival of Marking 2.0!

Already during the upcoming fall, the work with implementing the new and improved marking module, aka Marking 2.0 is under way. The present module will still be available until the end of 2021.

In comparison with the old module, there are many advantages that comes with Marking 2.0. Among other things:

- Less clicks
- Better overview
- Easier and faster to assess the student submissions
- Possible to annotate to all students/ co-graders at once
- Better navigation between the student submissions


Easier to choose your wanted views.

In a near future, it will be possible to change

an alternative, post-exam and to apply the new marks to all student submissions.

In future release, it will be possible to remove a whole question, post-exam.

Throughout the fall, we will train all new Academics in Marking 2.0 first-hand.. We will also offer training sessions in the new module for the rest of the Academics. Up to the end of 2021, it will be possible to switch between the different modules. As of 2022, the old module will be discontinued.

Inspira Remote Exam prevents cheating at remote exams!

JU is working with Inspira to be able to offer safe remote exams. Inspira has a new product in beta-testing, working on the needed single-sign-on functionality before a roll-out at JU

Inspira Remote Exam offers:

- Students will use Safe Exam Browser that temporarily locks the computer from accessing apps and the Internet during an ongoing exam
- Verification of identity via face-recognition at start and during the exam and at submission
- Advanced monitoring - warns of suspicious activities
- Watch recordings (video and sound) after suspicions of cheating and reporting to DAN
- Continuous surveillance, despite of temporary loss of Internet connection

New improved functionality to support the students to sit their exams remotely. Security control system:

1. System compatibility checks

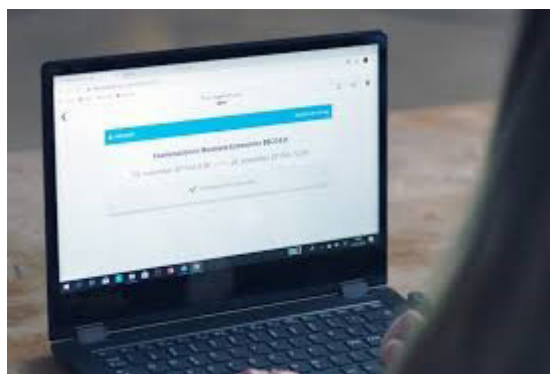
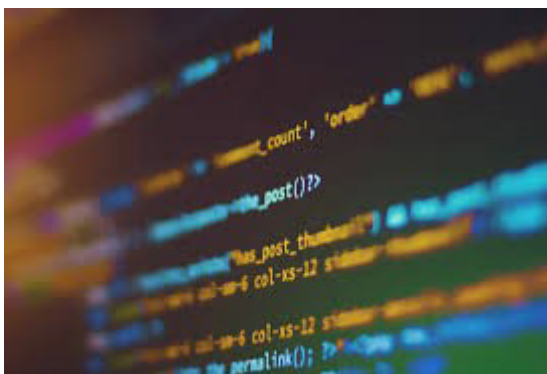
Inspira is making sure the student computer mic and web cam is working properly.

2. Automatic identity checks

Students will be authenticated using their web camera.

3. Manual identity controls

Deviations in identity may be manually checked by the invigilators.



Better reports from Urkund to Inspera

You may now find out who is behind the original submissions being plagiarized according to Urkund report.

Due to Corona and the increased need for anti-plagiarism, Inspera has developed the integration set-up between Inspera and Urkund.

That includes text matching in between all student submissions, individually, on an Inspera exam.

The reports, which, in the past, sometimes have been delayed, will now be delivered faster.

At the event of a report in Inspera from Urkund, Inspera, now, will provide the original text and the identity of the student behind the original submission.

The improvements will be present in Inspera as of September 11th.
