Intended Learning Outcomes (ILO)

On completion of the course, the doctoral student must

Knowledge and understanding

- be familiar with different learning perspectives
- demonstrate understanding of how students learn in relation to teaching in general and in relation to specific subjects
- demonstrate knowledge about different forms of examination and judgement

Skills and abilities

- demonstrate ability to independently analyse, argue and discuss, both orally and in written, in relation to planning, implementation and evaluation of teaching
- demonstrate ability to give account for and discuss consequences of various pedagogical methods on students learning
- demonstrate skills in communicating research results within the own area, in an interesting way and with focus on learning

Judgement and approach

- demonstrate ability to reflect and discuss the role of the teacher in higher education
- demonstrate ability to give and take feedback, with the purpose of analysing, evaluating and developing teaching and learning
- demonstrate ability to use different practical teaching tools and be able to judge their pros and cons, both for students and teachers

Contents

The course comprises basic teaching theories and practical tools supporting the participants' ability to communicate results and facilitate the learning of others.

The course includes the following elements:

- fundamental theories on communication, teaching and didactics

- various pedagogical methods and tools and their consequences for learning
- analyse, evaluate and develop teaching and learning
- examination forms and judgement
- how to communicate results and support others learning

Type of instruction

The course is based on lectures, seminars and auscultation. The course language is Swedish or English depending on the needs of the participants.

Prerequisites

Admitted to third-cycle programme or equivalent.

Examination and grades

The course is graded Fail (U) or Pass (G).

The course grade is Pass or Fail.

The examination is based on written reflection and practical assignments (holding an own lecture, auscultation with following reflection based of pedagogical theories).

Course certificate issued when written reflection and practical assignment is approved.
