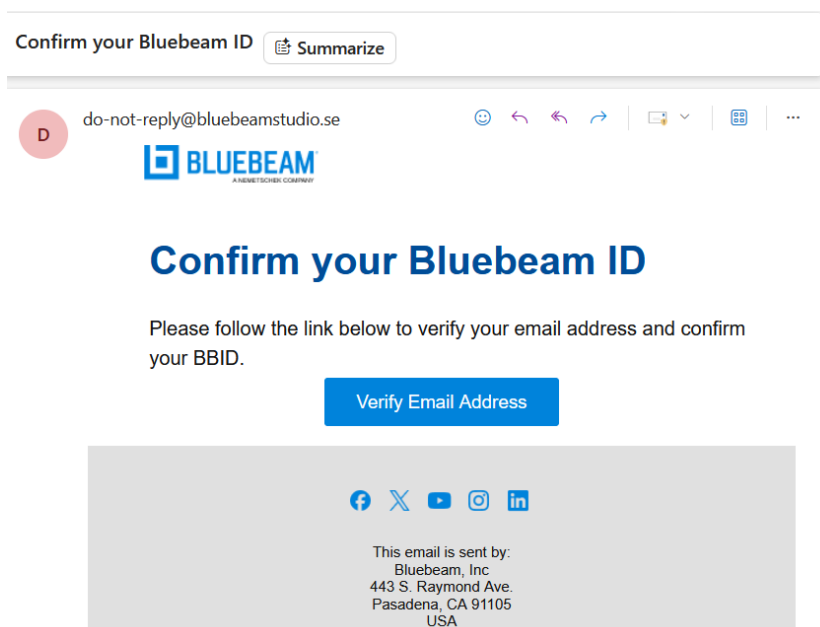
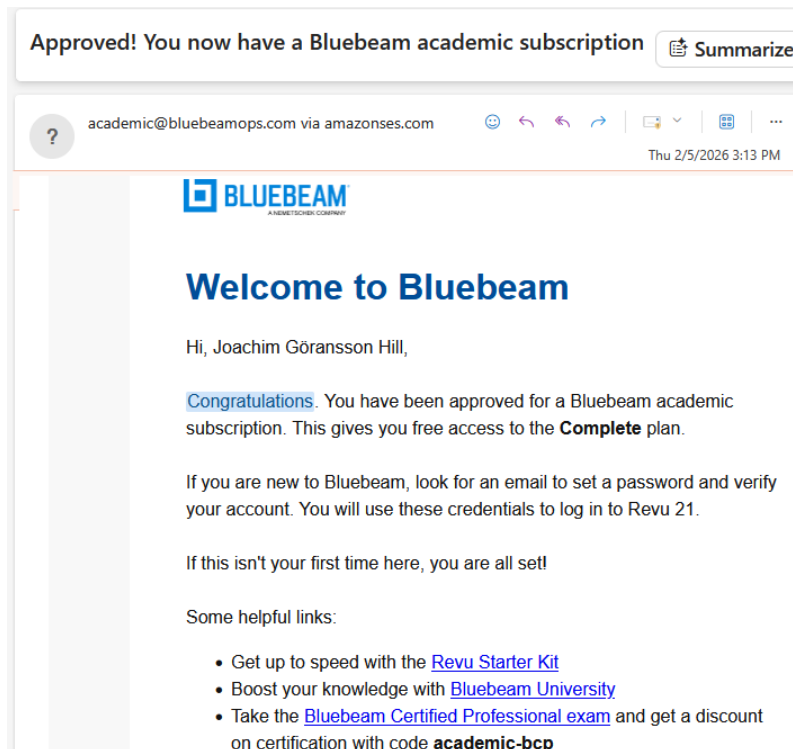

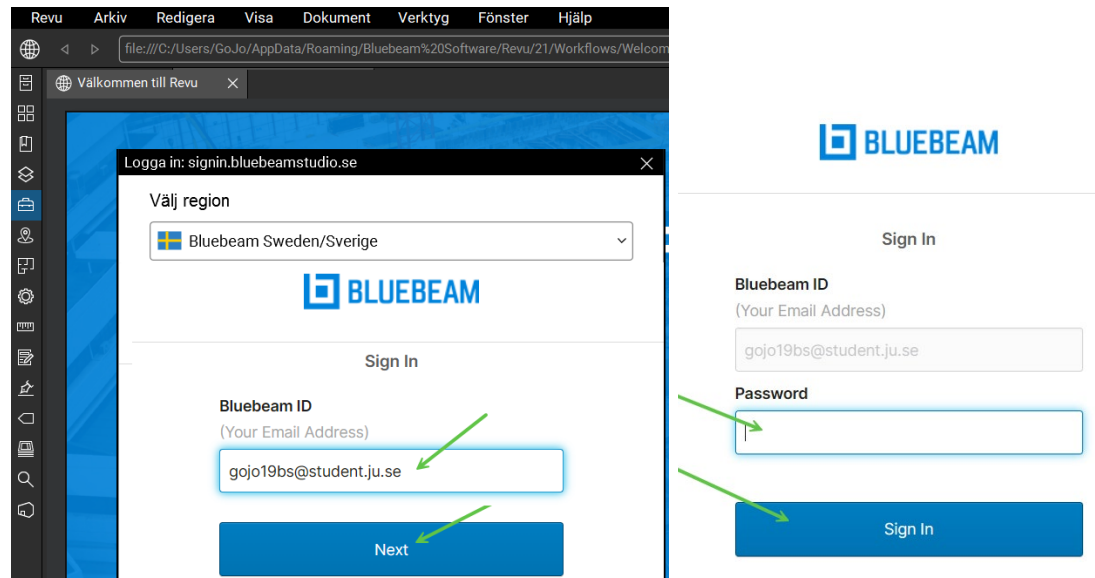


- 5) If you are using a JU (Jönköping University) computer, You can start Bluebeam Revu directly from the Start menu.
