

JIBS Grading Policy

JIBS normally uses a grading scale running from A to F. The grades A, B, C, D, and E are all passing grades. F or FX is provided when a student has not succeeded in reaching the required level for a certain element of examination or intended learning outcome. The grading scale Pass/Fail (P/F) can also be used – in Swedish: Godkänd/Underkänd (G/Us). Students that fail in getting a passing grade are offered re-examination in line with the re-examination regulations at Jönköping University.

For final course grades, the following applies:

Grade	Reference to grade	If all intended learning outcomes have been met, generally...*
A	EXCELLENT performance	90% of the maximum course point warrants the student an A.
B	VERY GOOD performance	80% of the maximum course point warrants the student a B.
C	GOOD performance	70% of the maximum course point warrants the student a C.
D	SATISFACTORY performance	65% of the maximum course point warrants the student a D.
E	SUFFICIENT performance	60 % of the maximum course point is needed to pass the course and get the grade E
FX or F	FAIL with some or a lot of work required before credit(s) can be awarded	Students who perform below 60 %will not pass the course.
