

Welcome to the Master of Science programme in Occupational Therapy at the School of Health and Welfare, Jönköping University!

You will be studying towards a Degree of Master (120 credits) with a major in Occupational Therapy. You have chosen to study this programme with a 50% study pace for a duration of four academic years (August 2023 – June 2027). Part-time (50%) study pace means approximately 20 hours of studies per week.

The programme is a web-based programme that uses the online learning management system, Canvas. All programme activities – such as lectures, real-time seminars, supervisions, and examinations – are conducted online. This means that there are **no** compulsory meetings on campus. Real-time meetings are held using Zoom.

Programme introduction

The introduction to the programme and the compulsory roll call will be on **Tuesday**, **29th August 2023**, **8:30-10:00 (CEST)**. This will be immediately followed by the introduction to the first course in the programme, Theory of Science and Scientific Method, which will be from **10:30-12:00 (CEST)**.
