## What can YOU do?

- **Confront directly!** Leave no room for misunderstanding.
- **Write down** what has happened, so you can easily process and document the incident.
- **Tell someone** you trust what has happened.
- **Contact** your OLIK ombud, teachers, study advisor, equal opportunities coordinator, student health care or chaplaincy for advice and support.
- **Report** the incident if you believe that it should be investigated formally.

## Diskrimination Act (2008:567)

The purpose of the Discrimination Act is to combat discrimination and promote equal rights regardless of ethnicity, religion, gender, gender identity or expression, disability, sexual orientation or age.

A higher education institution is obliged to investigate whether a student is exposed and, where appropriate, to take measures to prevent further harassment/discrimination.
