



To integrate children's perspective in health promotion interventions for children 8-12 years of age with experiences of cancer treatment

The project aims to explore from the perspective of children what promotes health in children 8-12 years of age with experience of cancer treatment and how this knowledge can be integrated and measured in health promotion interventions for these children. Focus groups have been conducted with children to explore their perceptions of health and friendship. Thereafter, workgroups with children and researchers have worked together and to integrate children's perspective to a health promotion intervention for these children. Furthermore, it is planned to explore and describe the research and development process of children as informants and co-researchers in the development of the health promotion intervention. A psychometric evaluation of the Swedish version of the Minneapolis Manchester Quality of Life (MMQL) instrument has been done in order to use the questionnaire in the evaluation of the health promotion intervention.
