Azure for Students is a service provided by Microsoft to enable students/teachers to evaluate and understand Information Technology. Software and services provided via Azure for Dev Tools and may not be used for the University's operation or for commercial purposes. Microsoft Azure Dev Tools includes, among other things, the latest version of Windows, but you won't find Microsoft Office here. You can reach the Office tools instead via the Office 365 service www.office.com with your regular JU account.

Students log in with their personal username followed by @student.ju.se and employees with their username followed by @ju.se.

You only have access to Microsoft Azure Dev Tools while you are an active student or employed at JU. You have the right to use the installed programs even after completing your studies/employment, but cannot download or request new license keys.

JU cannot control the availability, functionality and offerings associated with the Microsoft Azure Dev Tools website and cannot correct any errors or disruptions. In case of problems, you can try at a later time or contact Microsoft directly for further help. JU does not take responsibility for the individual's installation, provide support or take responsibility for any errors. If you use this free service, you are referred to the instructions available through the Microsoft Azure Dev Tools official help pages.


When you download software from the portal, you access these in a similar way to an online store. At one stage in the download process, a so-called product key is displayed. Product keys are personal. Make a note of it as you will need it during installation to confirm your right to install. If you lose the key, it can be retrieved at the same place where you download the programs.


After downloading an *.iso or *.img file, you can e.g. burn your software onto a CD/DVD to be able to install it on your computer. You can also mount it as a virtual CD/DVD player in Windows.













To download software, click on "Explore All" under "Free software".


This will open the Software tab on the left-hand side and show a list of available software.








To download Visio Professional, find Visio in the list, click on the name and then on "View key", now the product key and a Download link will appear.









Right-click and select "Open with" > "Windows Explorer"

The installation files will now be available as a new drive under "This computer"








When the installation is complete, and the program is launched for the first time, you will be prompted to enter the license key that you accessed through the Azure portal.
