

# Checklist for students - online and distance learning programmes at JU

## Activate your JU user account and register

For online and distance learning programme students, it is compulsory to register for the courses you have been admitted to and activate your JU user account before you can start your studies.

Firstly, follow the instructions on <https://activation.ju.se/loginselector> and create your own user account. You must have your registration number ("T-number") ready before you can register and create your account. Do you still not have your registration number, contact [Admissions.Office@ju.se](mailto:Admissions.Office@ju.se) . When you register and create your account, you will get a university email address which you must check on a regular basis, as we will send all important information and correspond to this.

Secondly, once you have created your account you also need to register for the programme and the courses for the first semester in the student registration system called *Ladok*, see [www.student.ladok.se](http://www.student.ladok.se) .

If you do not register on time before the roll call, you might lose your place on the programme.

## Attend Roll Call online via the web

For online and distance learning programmes, you still need to attend the obligatory roll call for your programme, but instead of coming to Jönköping, you attend the roll call online on a scheduled occasion. You'll find the location and time for your roll call in the pull down menu on [www.ju.se/newstudent](http://www.ju.se/newstudent).

Attending roll-call is compulsory for new students. If you do not attend the roll call, and has not informed us, you will lose your place on the programme.
