BACKGROUND and Purpose with the development of this area

One of the overall goals for Jönköping University (JU) in the years 2017-2021 is: *We will increase internationally competitive research*. The research at JU is conducted and organized at JU's four schools (Jönköping International Business School, School of Education and Communication, School of Engineering and School of Health and Welfare). Historically, there has been no joint organization to discuss overall and overlapping research questions at JU. Nevertheless, there is a demand for this from the researchers at JU and it's important with an overall structure and organization in which joint research issues can be discussed. This especially prior to the forthcoming quality reviews of research at colleges and universities at national level. A joint research organization should be available for support to researchers at different levels. It can touch issues like referral management, research grants, announcement of scholarships and more. The gap analysis made at JU demonstrated that the collaboration between the schools can be stronger and that resources could be better utilized, with opportunities to share important information and experiences. The recently formed Grants Office should be further developed in order to support researchers in, for example, grant applications.

During the year 2017 and spring 2018, organizational changes have been made with the aim of working more overarching within JU and the four schools, with among others research issues. A Grants Office has begun to be formed, a vice president Research has been appointed, and a strategic council for research has been established at JU. The Strategic Research Council is headed by the vice president Research and regular members are the deans of research of the respective *schools* and one PhD-student-representative. Grants Office is also permanently adjunct. In 2018 and 2019, the organization will develop, and the plan is to explore the possibility of establishing a JU Ethics Council to support researchers, and to establish and develop the Grants Office, according to the needs from the researchers.

Objective and output

The goal is an overarching research organization that can support researchers, and which promotes cooperation between the four *schools* and provides opportunities for comprehensive discussions.

Output

- Increased support for, and collaboration among, researchers as JU
- Increased opportunity for social impact, attraction and competitiveness
- Increased opportunity for external funding for research

Delivery targets

- Established strategic council for research
- Established grants office at JU
- Established ethics council at JU

Delimitations

The strategic council for research, and the developed organization, is aimed at research and postgraduate education and not to other education.
