1) Entrepreneur: Person & Process

The course is designed to provide students understanding and knowledge on Entrepreneur: Person and Process, for learning about entrepreneur features, fulfill the needs for an entrepreneurial mind-set, and for helping you as student to develop in the practices of a worldview. As a point of departure, this course brings an introduction to different theoretical perspectives on and facets of entrepreneurship as well as to the concept of "entrepreneuring" (that is entpreneurship as a process). Thus, the core of this course is to provide a foundation for the programme, as well. As such, learning for and in entrepreneurship, for example, will follow practices for identifying and developing venture ideas for new start-up, as well as, for established organizations.

2) Entrepreneurial Growth

The course takes an Entrepreneuring: Person and Process view, that communicates the ideological pillars of the programme, the students take the course Entrepreneurial Growth, which introduces learning about entrepreneurship and managing an entrepreneurial firm. In this course, academic work focus, will be through lectures, literature discussions, as well as writing of academic texts. Case studies and guest lectures construct a bridge to the world outside the academy.
